She was a member of St. John's Episcopal church and was an active member in the auxiliary of the Kanawha Medical Society.

Besides her husband she is survived by three sons Richard Kay, Danny and Timmy, all at home and a sister, Mrs. Robert J. Baber, of Charleston.

Funeral services were conducted this afternoon at 2 o'clock in the chapel of the First Presbyterian church of Charleston with Dr. George H. Vick officiating. Burial followed in the family plot of Mountain View cemetery.
