Mrs. Juergens, Former Resident Dies

Mrs. Evelyn Rippetoe Juergens, 48, wife of William L. Juergens, of Sutton, and a former resident of Hinton, died at her home in North Sutton Wednesday evening following an illness of several months. She had been in a critical condition for the past several weeks.

Mrs. Juergens was born May 29, 1896, the daughter of Walter and the late Mrs. Annie Lynch Rippetoe. She attended schools at Hinton and after graduating from high school here she studied music, specializing in piano.

She was married to Mr. Juergens April 23, 1924, and since that time has made her home at Sutton. Since moving there she has taken an active part in church and civic affairs of the community. She served as president of the Sutton Woman's club for the year 1943-44 and for many years served as pianist at St. Paul's Methodist church of which she was a member.

Besides her husband, she is survived by a son, William Jacob Juergens, at home; her father, and two sisters, Mrs. Watkins Hutchinson, of Newport News, Va., and Mrs. Kyle Erwin, of Ronceverte.

Funeral services were held at the home Friday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Interment was in the Sutton cemetery.
