EUGENE NICHOLS DEAD

It is our sad duty today to chronicle another death, the victim being W. Eugene Nichols, who died at his home on upper Third ave., Saturday night, about 9 o'clock. His death was due to that terrible malady pneumonia, and the end came after only a few days illness. Ere his fatal illness, he was a strong, healthy looking young man and his passing again exemplifies the uncertainty of life, especially against the ravages of pneumonia in its worst form.

Mr. Nichols was the oldest son of Mr. and Mrs. W. B. Nichols and was a popular and promising young man. He just recently enlisted in the service of his country and it was while on a visit to his home here that he was taken with his last illness. Besides his parents, he leaves one brother, Daniel, and his devoted young wife, who previous to her marriage to the deceased, only a few months ago, was Miss Ida Ware, of Alderson.

The remains, accompanied by relatives and friends, were taken to Alderson on No. 14 Sunday afternoon and were laid to rest in the cemetery there after fitting funeral services this afternoon.

Mr. Nichols was 22 years of age.

The bereaved ones have the sympathy of the community in their irreparable loss.
