Hugh W. Johnson Dies In Hospital

HINTON (RNS) — Hugh W. Johnson, 64, of 140 Pleasant St., Hinton, died at 10:35 a. m. Thursday in a Clifton Forge, hospital after a three-month illness.

Born in Detroit, Mich., Jan. 25, 1904, he was a son of the late Thomas J. and Annie Laura Bragg Johnson. He was a resident of Hinton for 55 years and was employed by the Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad as a carpenter for 45 years.

He was a member of the Central Baptist Church and the Men's Bible Class of the church and the Maintenance of Way for Carpenters.

Survivors include a sister, Mrs. Lola Groover of New Smyrna Beach, Fla., and six brothers, Gideon of Wayne, Mich., John of Walnut Creek, Calif., and Harry, Robert L., James and Richard, all of Hinton.
