### **Princeton Woman Dies After Gunshot Wound**

A 45-year-old Princeton woman died early Tuesday morning at her home, victim of an apparent self-inflicted gunshot wound.

Princeton city police identified the victim as Mrs. Lillian Faye Yost of 100 Tenth St., Princeton.

Detective Sgt. B. E. Belcher said Mrs. Yost shot herself once in the head with a .38 caliber handgun.

Born at True in Summers County, she was a daughter of the late Willie and Betty Martin Lemon. She had lived in Princeton for the past 17 years, coming from Bluefield. She was employed as a secretary at the Mercer County Bank in Princeton and was a member of the First Baptist Church.

Surviving are her husband, Aaron C. Yost; one son, William Aaron Yost of the home; four brothers, Roy Lemon and Carrie Lemon, both of Massilon, Ohio, and John Lemon and Junior Lemon, both of True; and one sister, Miss Onba Lemon of True.

Funeral services will be held Thursday at 3 p.m. at the George W. Seaver Chapel in Princeton with Rev. Paul Carter officiating. Burial will follow in Maple Hill Cemetery in Bluefield, Va. Employees of the Mercer County Bank will be pallbearers and will carry flowers.
