Rites Scheduled For Paul D. Price

HINTON (RNS) — Paul D. Price, 71, of 1017 Temple St. in Hinton died at 1 a.m. Thursday in a Hinton hospital where he had been a patient the past three weeks. Death was attributed to a heart attack.

Born April 7, 1900, at Catlettsburg, Ky., he was a son of the late William E. and Erma Blackburn Price. He had lived in Hinton since 1902.

After graduation from Hinton High School in 1918, he became affiliated with the Independent Herald, a now defunct weekly newspaper, and later worked with the Beckley and Bluefield papers as well as the Hinton Daily News.

For the past several years he had served as Summers County registrar.

He is survived by his wife, Margaret Butler Price of Hinton; one son, Charles E. Price, a pharmacist in Ohio; two sisters, Mrs. Ruth Meador and Mrs. Margaret Teaco, both of Hinton, and one brother, Harold Price of Hinton.

The funeral will be at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors with Dr. Clyde Hensley and Rev. W. R. McCoy in charge. Burial will be in Restwood Memorial Estates near Hinton.
