The sports are divided into three groups: (1) Major—including Indoor Soccer, Basketball, and Baseball; (2) Minor—Volley Ball and End Ball; (3) Individual—Quoitennis, Basketball shooting and Handball.

For participating in these sports the girls are awarded points. 1500 points are needed to win the coveted "H"; however, only 750 points are required for numerals. Besides this she must meet the requirements of scholarship and sportsmanship. Extra points are awarded for long hikes and other outdoor activities.
