## **Thomas Joseph McCarthy**

McCARTHY, Thomas Joseph (Joe) Sr. - Requiem Mass for Mr. McCarthy, 73, of Hinton, who died Thursday night, will be sung at 10 a.m. Monday in St. Patrick's Catholic Church in Hinton with Fr. T. L. Kerrigan as celebrant. Burial will be in Greenbrier Burial Park at Hinton, Rosary will be reciled at 8 p.m. tomorrow in Ronald Meadows mortuary chapel. The body will remain at the mortuary until the service. Mr. McCarthy died in C&O Hospital at Huntington after a one-month illness. He was a retired Chesapeake and Ohio Railway conductor and a member of the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen. A native of Raleigh County, he had lived in Hinton for 55 years. Surviving are his wife Ella; one son, Thomas J. McCarthy Jr. of Huntington: two daughters. Mrs. Leonard T. Anderson of Charleston and Miss Mary Elizabeth McCarthy of Hinton: one brother.
