Miss Mary Eloise Huffman, 86, of 513 4th Avenue, died Wednesday, April 12, at 6:15 p.m., at a Hinton hospital following a long illness.

Born September 14, 1902, at Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Oren Luther and Bertie Williams Huffman.

Miss Huffman had lived most of her life in Hinton and was a retired Summers County school teacher, retiring in 1967 with 43 years of service.

She was a member of the First United Methodist Church at Hinton, where she was a member of the Rachel Circle, the United Methodist Women and the Grace Allen Circle of Kings Daughters, also a member of the WVEA, the NEA and the Summers County Retired School Teachers Association.

She was preceded in death by two sisters, Lena Lantz and Geneva Lindsay and two brothers, Oren and James Huffman.

Survivors include two sisters, Elizabeth Huffman of Hinton and Emmajean Allred of Huntington; four nieces, and three nephews.

Services were held Saturday April 15 at 3 p.m. at the First United Methodist Church at Hinton with the Rev. Gerald Dotson officiating. Burial followed at the Greenbrier BurialPark at Hinton.

The body was at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors in Hinton and at the church one hour prior to the services.

Men of the church served as pallbearers.
