Sgt. Lilly, 23, Dies Of Auto Injuries

— Sgt. Alvin R. Lilly, 23, of Jumping Branch, stationed at George Air Force in Victorville, Calif., died Saturday of injuries received in a car accident.

Born at Hinton, March 11, 1946, he was a son of Ernest and Elsie Evans Lilly of Jumping Branch.

Lilly was graduated from Hinton High School in 1965 and attended the Gospel Tabernacle at Jumping Branch.
