Barbara Susan Keller, 89 formerly of 112 Greenbrier Drive Hinton died at 10:45 p.m. Saturday September 6, 2014 at Main Street Care in Hinton after a long illness.

Born December 12, 1924 at her home in Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Robert R. (Bob) & Nellie Hoover Keller. Barbara lived in the home she was born in all of her life before becoming ill.

Barbara held several jobs throughout her life including cashier-office clerk for F.W. Woolworth Company in Hinton, office clerk for her fathers' R.R. Keller Business Services, accounting clerk for the Department of Highways, bookkeeper for O.R. Grimmett Motor Company in Hinton, business office for the Hinton Hospital, secretary and office clerk for J.D. Woodrum, MD, medical records for Hinton Hospital, self-employed bookkeeping and taxes and payroll for Big 4 Drug Store and Massie Insurance Agency.

Barbara was a member of Central Baptist Church in Hinton.

She was the editor of the original Summers County Historical Society's Cemetery Book, which was published in 1996 and was named a West Virginia Hero in 1997.

Other than her parents, Barbara was preceded in death by a sister, Ruth Keller Gill and three brothers, Robert (Sonny) Ripley, II, Karl and David Keller, two nephews, Jack Gill and Thomas Keller, one niece, Karla Jo Keller and one great nephew, Jimmy Gill.
