

Clarence Henry "Jupe" Seldomridge December 5, 1931 – January 16, 2010

Clarence H. "Jupe" Seldomridge, Jr. of 5301 N. 26th St. Arlington, Virginia formerly of Hinton, West Virginia died Saturday January 16, 2010 at age 78 in the VA Medical Center in Arlington, Virginia.

Born December 5, 1931 in Hinton, West Virginia, "Jupe" was the son of the late Clarence H. Sr. & Pansy (Smith) Seldomridge. Mr. Seldomridge was a 1949 graduate of Hinton High School. Following high school, he entered the U.S. Air Force and was a veteran of the Korean War. Following military service, he graduated from West Virginia University in 1956 and received Masters in Education from West Virginia in 1957.
