Mrs. Polly Ann Turner, 38, of 102 Second St., died on or about Wed. Mar. 25, 1992, of an apparent drowning in an automobile accident.

Born Nov. 14, 1953, in Hinton, she was the daughter of the late James Edward and Joan Lilly Eggeston.

Mrs. Turner was a lifelong resident of Hinton, graduated from the Raleigh County Vocational School of Practical Nursing, receiving her Licensed Practical Nurse Certificate in Dec. 1989 and was a former LPN at the Humana Greenbrier Valley Hospital at Fairlea. She was a member of the Central Baptist Church at Hinton, was a graduate of Hinton High School and attended Concord College.

She was preceded in death by a daughter, Vicky Lynn Turner in 1973.

Survivors include her husband, Robbie Turner; a daughter, Sherri Renee Turner at home; a son, Robert W. Turner at home; three brothers, Jerry Eggeston and James Eggeston, Jr., both of Hinton, and Bobby Eggeston of Ripley; a sister, Mrs. John (Jean) Taylor of Hinton; and several nieces and nephews.

Services were held at 2 p.m. Mon. Apr. 6 at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlor Chapel, Hinton, with the Revs. Robert Moore and Frank Pittman officiating. Burial followed in the Restwood Memorial Gardens at Hinton.
