Pipestem State Park

Name derived from a native narrow leaf meadowsweet plant, used for making pipe stems.

Funded with grants by Area Redevelopment Administration of the U.S. Department of Commerce under the administration of President John F. Kennedy, urged by local community leader, John Faulconer, and WV Senator Robert Byrd. 1

4050 acres at an elevation of 2383 ft. Avg. (2932' to 1550')

Contains a 1,000 ft. elevation Tram, an 18 hole golf course, a par 3 golf course, 113 guest room McKeever Lodge, 30 guest room Mountain Creek Lodge, 26 guest Cabins, a Campground with 82 sites, horseback riding, indoor and outdoor swimming pools, and several other activities.

Park construction began in 1963.

Par 3 Golf Course completed 1967.

18 hole Golf Course completed 1969.

Park officially opened Memorial Day 1970.

The Park hosts over a million visitors per year.






