He was a member of the 1925 graduating class of Hinton High School, served a term as Justice of the Peace in Greenbrier District, and was an office deputy sheriff in the early 1940's. Survivors include a brother, Carl Miller of Huntington; two sisters, Mrs. Gwinn Bowling and Mrs. Charles Hedrick, both of Hinton.
