— Charles R. McCallister, 55, of Red Sulphur Springs died Wednesday evening in a Hinton hospital after a short illness.

Born at Hinton, Sept. 20, 1919, he was a son of the late Charles H. and Eula Eary McCallister.

He was a member of the Peterstown Christian Church, was a veteran of World War II and a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 4500 at Hinton.
