Mr. Bobcat is chosen annually by the Senior class. He serves as our mascot at our ballgames during the year.

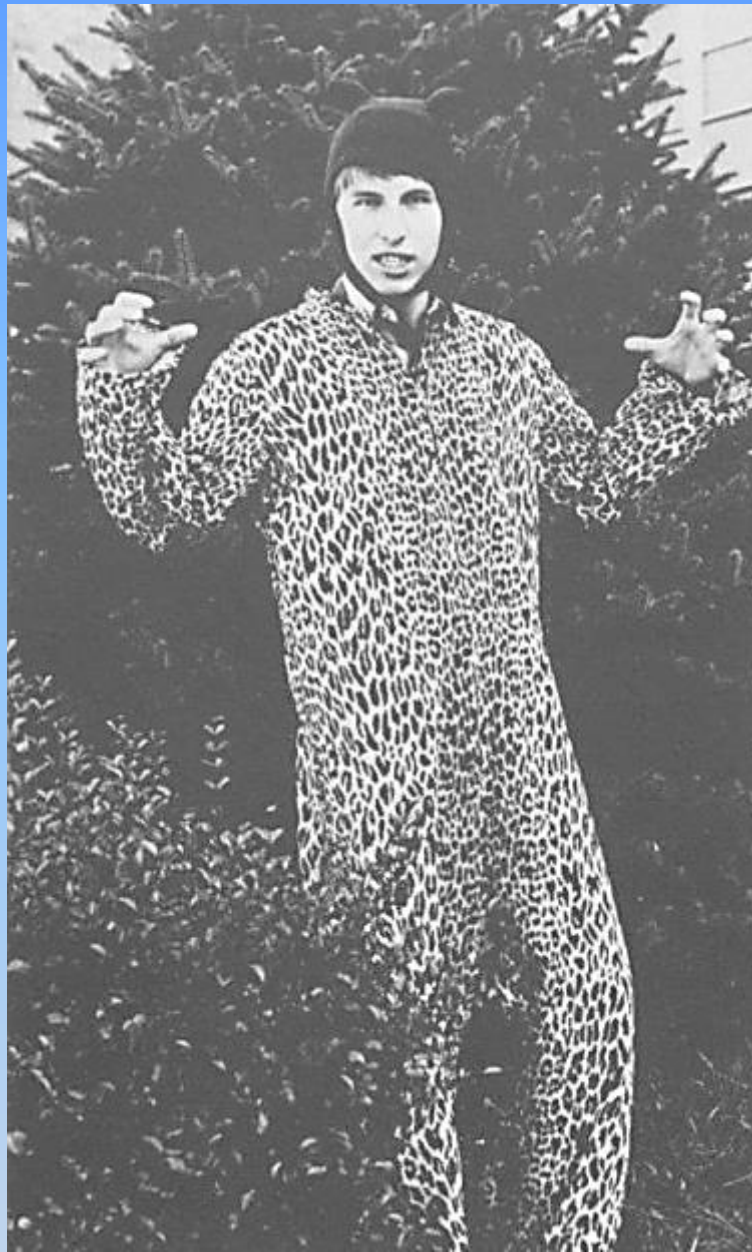
