WILLIAM C. LILLY, 56, DIES AT MARIE HOME

William C. Lilly, 56, died at his home near Marie this morning at 4:5 o'clock after an illness of two months. He suffered a cerebral hemorrhage on October 18 and his condition had steadily grown worse.

Born at Dunns, Mercer County, November 4, 1898, he was the son of the late Hiram and Emam Meadows Lilly and had lived most of his life in Summers and Monroe counties.

Mr. Lilly had lived near Marie for the past 25 years where he was actively engaged in farming and had been a school teacher in the county for fourteen years prior to 1938. He was a member of the Indian Creek Lodge AF&M No. 73.

Survivors include his widow, Mrs. Grace Lilly at home; three sons, Denver Lilly of Hildale, Dewey and Herbert Lilly of Marie; one daughter, Mrs. Ina Gwinn of Shady Springs; five grandchildren; one brother, Clarence Lilly, of Pipestem; four sisters, Mrs. Wanonta Albert of Princeton, Mrs. Effie Brooks, Wyoming; Mrs. Mamie Brown of Oceana, Mrs. Robert Farley, Pipestem.

The body will remain at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors pending completion of arrangements.
