Probe Death Of Woman At Beverley Beach

County Police were awaiting an autopsy report this morning on a Virginia woman who was found dead Saturday floating on her back in two feet of water at Beverley Beach.

Police Chief Edward C King identified the victim as Mrs Margaret Ann Snyder, 37, of Arlington.

She her husband Gilbert Snyder and three young children were vacationing at a beach cottage

Mrs Snyder was discovered near a stone jettv by two small unidentified children. Her husband told police he last saw her about 5 P M as she was wading out toward a float Her body was recovered about 5:30 P M by life guard Otis Huston

Medical examiner Dr Emily Wilson pronounced Mrs Snyder dead at 7:35 P M and ordered the autopsy. Death due to drowning was not given as the cause because the woman was found near a jetty in shallow water, and the body was floating

Investigating the death were police from the Edgewater substation
