Francis H. Surber, 91, of Harrisonburg, VA, formerly of Hinton, died 1:10AM Wednesday, August 10, 2011 at Harrisonburg, VA following a long illness.

Born March 9, 1920 at Hinton, he was a son of the late Charles and Champie Surber who lived the early part of his life in Hinton.

Francis was an Army Veteran of WWII who retired from C&O Railroad. During his employment he worked as a ticket agent at "The Greenbrier Hotel" and later at the Computer Center in Baltimore, MD. He was a member of the Spring Creek Church of the Nazarene in Harrisonburg and a former member of the Central Baptist Church in Hinton.
