E.E. “Ricky” Richmond, 77, of 504 Cedar Ave., Hinton, died at 5 a. m. Wednesday, Oct. 10, 2001, at his home following an apparent heart attack.

Born Sept. 17, 1924, in Brooks, he was the son of Mrs. Myrtle Atkins Richmond of Hinton and the late O. L. Richmond.

Mr. Richmond was a lifelong resident of Hinton. He was a U.S. Navy veteran of World War II, having served in the European Theatre. He was a retired conductor for C& O Railway and a member of the United Transportation Union.

He was preceded in death by a sister, Nina Jean Honaker.
