Hinton-26 Princeton-0

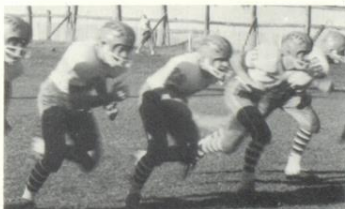
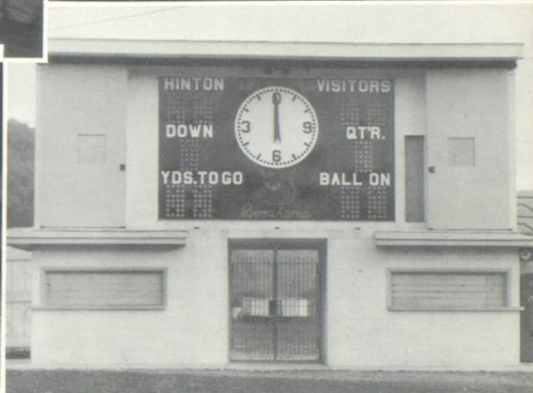
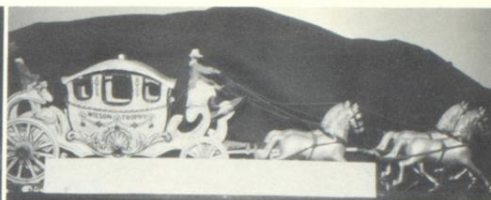

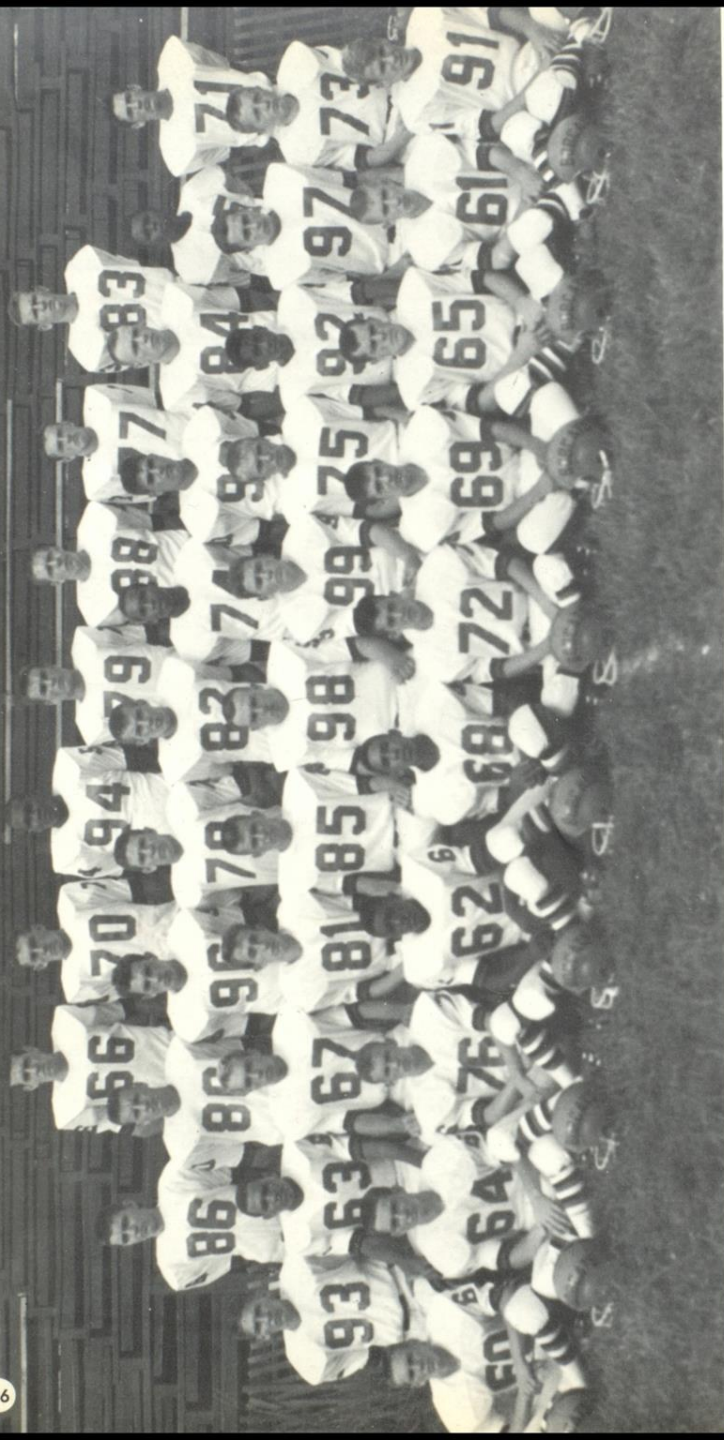
Hinton-7 Bluefield-34
