MRS. TANNER DEAD

Mrs. Tony Tanner, age 21 years, died shortly before three o'clock this afternoon of tuberculosis. She had been ill for the past year. At the time of her death she was at the home of her parents Captain and Mrs. W. S. Wade. She is survived by one child, a son, John, just a little more than two years old. This child is now very ill and is lying, itself, at the point of death.

WAS THE DEATH OF MRS. TONY TANNER—HUSBAND WAS ABSENT AND INFANT SON NEAR DEATH.

Death in its most pathetic form came yesterday evening to the home of Tony Tanner, 1233 Sixth avenue, when his young wife passed away after a protracted illness from tuberculosis. At the time of the death Mr. Tanner was away from home and the two-year-old baby boy is now so ill that it seems likely it will be buried soon beside its mother. Mrs. Tanner was at the home of her father, Captain W. S. Wade, at the time of her death and many loving friends surrounded the bed.

Funeral arrangements will be necessarily postponed awaiting the arrival of Mr. Tanner, who has been sent for.
