Mrs. Clara Louise Porter, 87, died of natural causes Tuesday, November 17, at a Hinton hospital.

Born September 28, 1900, in Summers County, she was the daughter of the late James Robert and Louise Bush Baber.

Mrs. Porter was a retired school teacher and a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Hinton, Stitch and Chatter Club, Hinton Garden Club and the Summers County Retired Teachers Association.

Survivors include a stepdaughter, Jane Young of Seattle, Wash.; a brother, Bob Baber of Hinton; two grandchildren, three great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.

Services were held Friday November 20 at 2 p.m. at the First Presbyterian Church at Hinton with Chaplain Dean Veltman officiating. Burial followed in the Hilltop Cemetery at Hinton.

The body was at the E. M. Meadows Funeral Home in Hinton and at the church one hour prior to the services.
