Born in Summers County, she was the daughter of the late Anderson E. and Jenny I. Hutchinson Miller.

Miss Miller was a charter member and the oldest living member of the Miller Memorial Methodist Church. The Millers were a pioneer family of Summers County. She was an honorary member of the Wednesday Club, and a member of the United Daughters of the Confederacy.

Survivors include one sister, Barbara M. Murrell of Hinton; a nephew, and two great-nieces.

Services will be Saturday at 11 a.m. at the Miller residence on Ballengee Street with the Rev. Bob Crumbly officiating. Entombment will be in the Miller Mausoleum.
