Martha Jane Humphries, 83, of 414 Fourth Ave., Hinton, died at 2:30 a. m. Friday, May 19, 2000, at her home.

Born Dec. 14, 1916, in Hinton, she was the daughter of the late Harry G. and Martha Jane Graham Humphries. Miss Humphries received a bachelor's degree in elementary education from Concord College and a master's degree from Marshall University. She was a retired school teacher with 35 years of service, having taught in several Summers County schools and served as principal of the former Bellepoint Elementary School in Hinton.

She was a member of the national, state and county teachers associations and the West Virginia Education Association. She was an active member of the Delphi Club, Service Club, Wednesday Club and Hinton Women's Club. She was a member of the Business and Professional Women's Club, Hinton, and the Graham House Preservation Society and served on the board of the Summers County Public Library. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, Hinton, and a lifelong resident of Hinton.

Survivors include two sisters, Betty Measer of Fayetteville, N.C., and Emily Warden of Charleston; a niece, Libby Crick of Palm Beach Gardens, Fla.; a nephew, Lacy Warden of Barrow, Alaska; a great-niece, Katherine Warden of Barrow; and a great-nephew, Jamie Crick of Palm Beach Gardens.
