Julian M. Meadows, 63, of 922 Temple St., died Friday November 26, at 5 a.m. in a Roanoke, Va., hospital after a short illness.

Born Feb. 11, 1919, at Hinton, he was a son of the late Russell L. and Mable Whanger Meadows.

Mr. Meadows was a retired conductor for the C & O Railroad, a World War II veteran, a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Hinton, the Hinton Elks Lodge and a member of the United Transportation Union.

Survivors include his wife, Pauline Walthall Meadows; two sons, Julian M. Meadows Jr. of Lewisburg and David Meadows of Oak Hill; a brother, Marvin Meadows of Lucasville, Ohio; a sister, Sarah White of Rochester, N.Y., and five grandchildren.

The body was at the E.M. Meadows Funeral Home in Hinton. The funeral was held Sunday November 28 at 2 p.m. with the Rev. William Young and the Rev. Al Cone officiating. Burial followed in the Greenbrier Burial Park.
