## Dr. J. W. Stokes Dedication

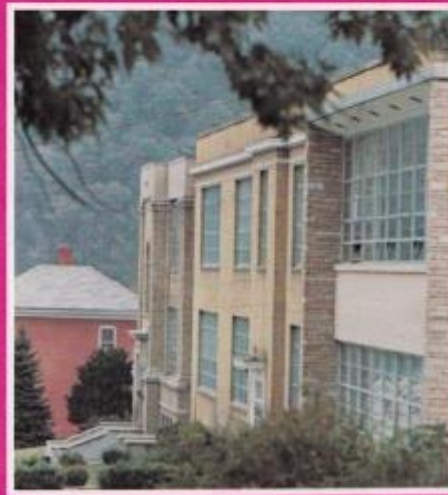

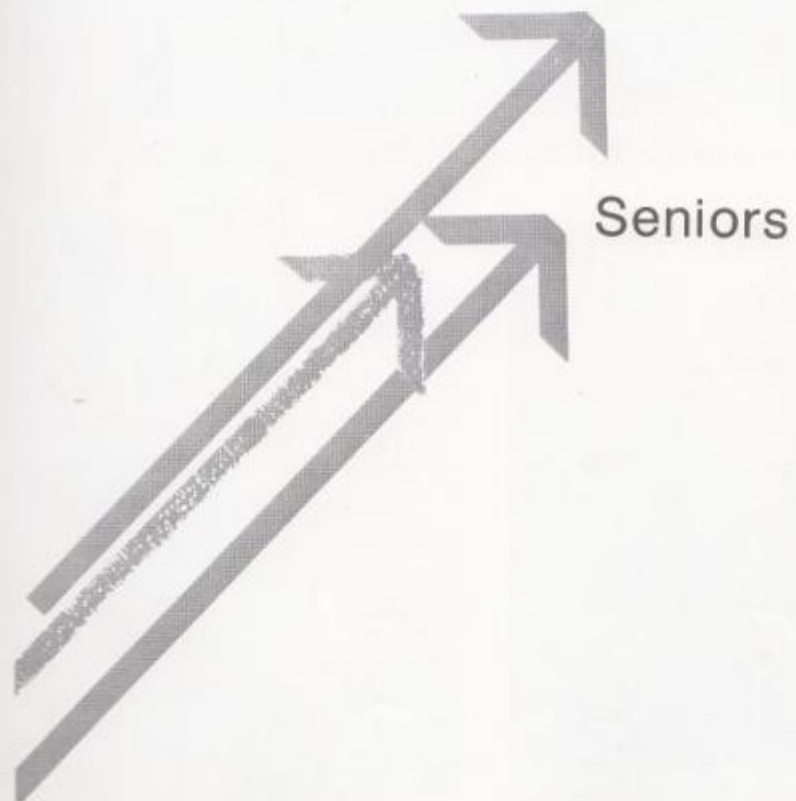
