Greenbrier Man Dies In Hospital

LEWISBURG (RNS) — Clair Ernest (Jack) Cooper of Lewisburg died Sunday in a Cumberland, Md., hospital.

He was a son of the late Gordon Lee and Nancy Elizabeth Meadows Cooper.

Cooper was manager of the Lewis Theatre in Lewisburg for 19 years.

He was a member of the Old Stone Presbyterian Church in Lewisburg, Greenbrier Lodge No. 42, Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, 32nd Degree Mason, Beni Kedem Shrine in Charleston and Modern Woodmen of America.

Survivors include his wife, Evelyn Swartz Cooper; a daughter, Mrs. Dick Hott of Cumberland, Md.; a brother, John A. Cooper of Newport News, Va.; a sister, Mrs. R. B. Dell of Denver, Colo., and one grandson.

The funeral will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday in the Old Stone Presbyterian Church with Rev. R. A. Pfrangle in charge. Burial will be in the Hill Top Cemetery at Hinton.

Masonic graveside rites will be conducted.
