Robert S. (Cooneye) Turner, 73, formerly of Hinton, died Monday at home of an apparent heart attack.

Born Nov. 20, 1907, in Hinton, he was a son of the late Robert B. and Barbara Scott Turner.

Mr. Turner, a 21-year resident of Fort Lauderdale, was a retired assistant manager of Belk Lindsey Co. in Fort Lauderdale, a member of the First Presbyterian Church in Fort Lauderdale, World War II veteran, a member of Hinton Elks Lodge Thomas Johnson Post 22 and American Legion Post.

Survivors include his wife, Margaret Jackson Turner; two daughters, Mrs. Barbara Willey and Mrs. Rebecca Hines, both of Fort Lauderdale; a brother, Thomas H Turner of Charleston and four grandchildren.
