JAMES RALPH HARRIS, 82, passed away Sun. Aug. 7, 2005 in Russell Kentucky.

Born in Hinton, WV on April 23, 1923, he was the son of the late John Elmer Harris and Mary Estes Bowles.

He was a graduate of Hinton High School, Class of 1941.

He proudly served his country in the United States Army during WWII. He won the Silver Star and French Croix de Guerre in Europe. From September 1944 to the end of the war, he was never out of artillery range.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his sister, Beulah Harris Quisenberry; and three brothers, John Bowles, Edward Creigh, and George Russell Harris
