LISA D. GORE DIES AT HINTON

Miss Lisa Dawn Gore, 18, died Saturday, April 25, from injuries received from a car accident, according to State Police in Hinton.

Born June 10, 1968, at Hinton, she was the daughter of Judith Ann Ballard Gore of Hinton and the late Perry Gore.

Miss Gore was a senior student at Hinton High School, member of the First Baptist Church at Hinton, member of the Girls Basketball Team and attended the Summers County Vocational School.

Other survivors include one brother, Perry (Butch) Gore of Hinton, and maternal grandmother, Pearl Ballard of Hinton.

Services were held Sunday May 10 at 2 p.m. at the First Baptist Church at Hinton with the Rev. D. D. Elwell officiating. Burial followed in the Restwood Memorial Gardens at Hinton.

There was no visitation.

The body was taken to the church one hour prior to services.
