Mr. Peck is a relative of the W. V. Peck family, of Princeton. Among the relatives who attended the funeral were Mr. and Mrs. Waldo Shumate, John Phillip of East Princeton. Shumate was a graduate of the 1918 class of Hinton high, took preparatory work at West Virginia university, and graduated with honors in law at the University of Virginia in 1925. For the last eight months he had been practicing law as a member of the Summers county bar; he was divorce commissioner and city attorney. He was a Mason and an Elk, and was 25 years of ago.
