Mrs. Womack Dies In Hospital; Rites Saturday

Mrs. Ida Womack, 63, wife of Robert L. Womack of 319 Seventh Avenue, died at 9:50 p.m. Wednesday in the Hinton Hospital after an extended illness.

Mrs. Womack suffered a stroke in September 1946 and had been a semi-invalid since that time. She had been bedfast for the last eight years. Her condition became critical Sunday and she was removed to the hospital.

Born at Steele, Va., Feb. 4, 1895, a daughter of the late Mr. and Mrs. W. P. Ware, she lived the early part of her life at Alderson and had been a resident of Hinton for the past 35 years.

She was a member of the Hinton Methodist church.

Besides her husband, she is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Alice Ann Atkins of Hinton, one granddaughter and one brother, W. P. Ware Jr. of Clifton Forge, Va.

Services will be held at 2 p.m. Saturday at Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors with the Rev. Ross Evans, Rev. J. F. Atkins and Rev. Harry V. Wheeler officiating.

Burial will follow in the Alderson cemetery at Alderson. The body will remain at the funeral home.
