Former Principal Of Hinton High Dies in Virginia

HINTON—Elber Wilson Taylor, 86, of Falls Church, Va., formerly of Hinton died Wednesday in a Fairfax, Va., hospital after an extended illness.

He was a former school teacher at Hinton High School and served one year as principal at Hinton High School. Mr. Taylor also served eight years as superintendent of Hinton Independent School District. He had also been a principal in Calhoun County. He was past president of Cabell County Teachers Assn. and a member of the West Virginia Teachers Assn. and the National Teachers Assn. He was a member of the Highland United Methodist Church, Huntington.
