

Dedication Mr. and Mrs. Garten



This Sports Section is dedicated to two people who have contributed a great deal to Hinton Athletics. Coaches Bill and Elaine Garten have combined to have many winning seasons for Hinton teams in the past, yet now they are both retired from the coaching profession.

After coming to Hinton in 1949 upon graduating from Concord College, Mrs. Garten started teaching as well as establishing a fine coaching career. In the beginning of her career her Lady Bobcats played college teams such as Concord and Bluefield State. Probably one of her most successful seasons came in 1979 when she took her team to the Regional Finals only to lose to eventual State Champions Northfork in overtime.

Coach Bill Garten ended a brilliant coaching career in 1979. Looking back over the years, Coach Garten pointed out the 1968 AA Championship team as undoubtedly the highlight of his career. At one time or another, Coach Garten was the head coach in all four major sports including football, basketball, baseball, and track. He once led his basketball club to the finals in the Regionals only to lose to Oceana in the championship by one point.

Pointing back to his football teams, Coach Garten also led his team to the State Championship in 1963, yet fell short. Of his 23 years as head coach in football, he had 18 winning seasons, and if present day ranking system were used his teams would have reached the play-offs 13 times. During his career he coached 5 of his young men to High School All-American honors, and 29 to All-State honors. In 1974 he recorded his 100th football victory, and in 1979 finished a spectacular career with a 143-89-2 record.

All of the many athletes who have passed through the instruction of these two fine coaches have developed respect and admiration for them both. They taught the values of both winning and losing and respecting other people. They both continue to teach P.E. at Hinton, but for their past achievement in the field of coaching, our congratulation and thanks are not enough.


