HINTON GIRL'S FUNERAL SET

Prominent Young Lady Dies After Appendicitis Operation

HINTON, Sept. 18.—Funeral services for Miss Clara Elizabeth Reid, 20 years old, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. S. C. Reid, of Sixth avenue, who died early Wednesday morning at the Hinton hospital, will be held this afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the Central Baptist church, with Rev. H. P. Hackney, pastor, officiating, assisted by Rev. E. W. Billings. Burial will follow in the Greenbrier burial park.

Miss Reid had been ill almost three weeks. She underwent an operation at the hospital about two weeks ago for removal of appendix, but peritonitis developed and her condition had been critical for several days before her death.

The young woman was graduated from Hinton high school in 1935. She was a member of the Central Baptist church and was a teacher of a Sunday school class there besides being a member of the senior and junior choirs.

The body will remain at the home of Mrs. C. B. Ball, 122 Temple street, until time for funeral services. Active pallbearers will be members of her graduating class, while honorary pallbearers will be selected from the B. Y. P. U. of the Central Baptist church.

Besides the parents, she is survived by one sister, Nadine, and a brother, Cecil, all of Hinton.
