SOUTH CHARLESTON — W. H. 'Pete' Bishop, 63, formerly of Beckley, died Friday, Feb. 28, in a South Charleston hospital, following a short illness.

Born Sept. 15, 1928, at Hinton, he was the son of Thelma Spade Shelor of Sparta, N.C., and the late Howard Bishop.

Mr. Bishop was a U.S. Air Force Korean Conflict veteran, a former W.Va. State Policeman and a Special Investigator for the State of W.Va. Commission on Special Investigations. He was a member of the Beckley Masonic Lodge No. 95, the Beni Kedem Temple and the First Baptist Church, Hinton.

Survivors include his wife, Helen Looney Bishop; and a daughter, Kimberly Dickey of Charleston.
