## Hinton Man Dies; Rites Incomplete

HINTON, May 7 (RNS) — A. Herman Fredeking, 56, of Hinton died in a Huntington hospital at 10:15 p. m. Tuesday after a long illness. He had been in ill health since 1953.

Born at Hinton, Dec. 29, 1901, he was a son of the late Charles H. and Katherine Culliney Fredeking.

Fredeking was a lifelong resident of Hinton except for a period during World War II when he was employed by the Naval Yard in Portsmouth, Va.

He was employed by the Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Co. as a machinist until his retirement.

Survivors include two sisters, Mrs. Walter L. Glass and Miss Sadie Fredeking, both of Hinton.
