James L. Wiseman, 53, of 113 Orchard Ave., Beckley, formerly of Hinton, died Tuesday April 5 at 5:45 p.m.

Born Jan. 8, 1930, in Hinton, he was a son of the late John and Francis Nadal Huston Wiseman.

Mr. Wiseman was the manager of the East Beckley Station of the Beckley Post Office and had worked for the postal service since 1956. He was a former employee of the Haleigh Motors Sales, a Korean War Army veteran serving in the Army from 1951- 1953 in Germany. He was a resident of Beckley since 1951, a member of the Beckley Elks Lodge 1482, the Beckley Fraternal Order of Police, a former member of the Beckley Jaycees, a former member of the Beckley Moose Club and a member of the Kentucky Colonel Club.

Survivors include his wife, Loretta Jo Turner Wiseman; a brother, Richard L. Wiseman of Beckley; a sister, Mrs. Frank (Ila) Warren of Beckley.

Services were held Friday April 8 at 1 p.m. in the Melton Mortuary chapel in Beckley with the Revs. Lester L. Hall and D. Homer Stewart officiating. Entombment was in the Blue Ridge Memorial Gardens Mausoleum in Prosperity.
