Lawrence Goode Taken By Death

An illness of 10 years today caused the death of Lawrence O. Goode, 22, of White Sulphur Springs, a former resident of Hinton.

Young Goode, a graduate of Hinton High school, died of arthritis which had partially crippled him since he was 12 years old. He had been bedfast for three years.

He was a son of Mrs. L. M. Goode. His father, a former C. & O. railway clerk here, died four years ago, and at that time Mrs. Goode and her three sons moved to White Sulphur Springs.

In addition to his mother, survivors include two brothers, Morris, at home, and Capt. Edward S. Goode, with the U. S. Air Force in California; and Mrs. W. J. Martin, of Hinton, an aunt.

Funeral arrangements were not learned.
