James Kemper Dawson, Jr., 70, died Sunday September 7 at a Roanoke, Va. hospital of natural causes.

Born July 5, 1916, at Clifton Forge, Va., he was the son of the late James K. Dawson Sr. and Merle Thomas Dawson.

Mr. Dawson was a retiree of the C&O Railroad Company, a lifelong member of the Veterans of Foreign War, a U.S. Army Air Corps World War II Veteran and a member of the First Christian Church of Hinton.
