RICHMOND, Va. — Mrs. Lois Quesenberry Ferrell, 99, formerly of Hinton, died Tuesday, Nov. 27, in a Richmond care center, following a long illness.

Born April 5, 1891, at Clifftop, she was the daughter of the late Dr. George O. and Sallie Mobley Quesenberry.

Mrs. Ferrell moved to Hinton in 1896, was a 1909 graduate of Hinton High School, moving to Richmond in 1920 and was a graduate of the University of Richmond.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Charles W. Ferrell in 1948.

Survivors include three nephews, George A. Saul of Mobile, Ala., Dr. Charles Saul of Beckley and Robert Quesenberry of Charleston, and a niece, Sarah Lowe Meadows of Columbia, S.C.

Graveside services and burial will be Friday at 1 p.m. at the Ferrell Family Cemetery at Forest Hill with the Rev. Robert Moore officiating.

There will be no visitation.
