Harvey C. Ballengee, 72, of Bellepoint died at 5 a.m. Saturday in a Hinton hospital following a six-months illness.

Born Aug. 16, 1896 at Bellepoint, he was the son of the late Robert H. and Elizabeth Jane Turner Ballengee.

He was a lifelong resident of Bellepoint and was employed by the Chesapeake and Ohio Railway Co. as a clerk in 1924 and retired in 1968.

A member of the Miller Memorial Methodist Church at Bellepoint, he was also a member of Hinton Masonic Lodge No. 62, Knights Templar, York Tiler Emeritus of Grand Chapter Royal Arch Masons, Order of Eastern Star No. 5, and Railway Clerks of America. He was a veteran of World War I.

He is survived by his wife, Beatrice; one son, William, Chicago, Ill.; one daughter, Miss Elizabeth Ballengee, at home; two brothers, Henry, of Vienna and George of Clearwater, Fla.

Funeral services will be at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at Miller Memorial Methodist at Bellepoint with the Rev. Charles S. Dameron and Dr. Fred B. Wyant in charge. Burial will be in the Mount Carmel Cemetery at Gap Mills.
