She returned stateside and worked at Aberdeen Proving Ground, Md. She was reassigned to a M.A.S.H. unit and spent a 14-month tour in southern Korea. She retired as an operating room nurse from the Walter Reed Medical Center.

She was a Hinton High School graduate and a graduate of the Norwegian School of Nursing in Brooklyn, N.Y. in 1935.
