HINTON – Seymour J. Graham of Hinton, died Saturday in Hinton Hospital, Hinton, after a long illness.

He was a native and lifelong resident of Hinton. Mr. Graham was a banker, retired from the First National Bank of Hinton. He was a member of the First Presbyterian Church of Hinton, the Hinton Kiwanis Club, the Hinton Masonic Lodge, the Beni-Kedem Shrine of Charleston, the VFW, the Elks and the West Virginia Planning Comm. He was director of Mountaineer Travel Council. Mr. Graham was a World War I veteran.
