Frank O. Lilly, 55, Dies in City Home

Frank Otho Lilly, 55, of 5617 Noyes Av., died at his home last night of a heart condition.

Mr. Lilly, a resident of Charleston for more than 30 years, was operator of Lilly Drug Store at 57th St. and MacCorkle Av. in Kanawha City.

He was born Feb. 12, 1895 at Jumping Branch, Summers County, son of the late Dr. John and Elizabeth Meador Lilly.

Mr. Lilly was a member of Westminster Presbyterian Church of Kanawha City, Salina Lodge AF&AM of Malden, York Rite Bodies, a 32nd Degree Scottish Rite Mason, Beni Kedem Shrine, and a charter member of the Shrine Oriental Band, of which he was a past president.

He was also a veteran of World War I and a graduate of West Virginia University.

Surviving are his wife, Mrs. Verma Zimmerman Lilly; one son, Frank E. Lilly, a student at West Virginia University; one daughter, Miss Margaret Lilly, at home; two sisters, Mrs. Sam McClung of Hinton and Mrs. Lydia Harper of Charleston, and one brother, Alfred Lilly of Jumping Branch.
