Bob Ray Ballengee, 63, formerly of Hinton, died Tues. Oct. 1, 1991, in a Charleston hospital, following a short illness.

Born Mar. 1, 1928, at Hinton, he was the son of the late Ira and Neva Wiseman Ballengee.

Mr. Ballengee was a retired conductor from the CSX Transportation, a member of the United Transportation Union, a Korean Conflict veteran and a member of the VFW and the American Legion.

He was preceded in death by two brothers, Paul and Jack Ballengee.
