Clara Hill Dies; Funeral Friday

HINTON (RNS) — Mrs. Clara Hill, 81, died at 2:45 a.m. Wednesday in a Hinton Hospital where she had been a patient for a month. She had been in ill health and underwent surgery several weeks ago.

Born Nov. 30, 1882, in Hinton, she was a daughter of the late Henry and Amanda Bailey.

She was a lifelong resident of Hinton.

Mrs. Hill was organist at the Central Baptist Church, of which she was a charter member, for more than 50 years.

Mrs. Hill was a member and past president of the Hinton Chapter, United Daughters of the Confederacy and member and past president of the Hinton Chapter of the Woman's Club. In 1959, she was chosen as Hinton's Mother of the Year.

Survivors include her husband, C. Allen Hill, and a number of nieces and nephews.

The funeral will be held at 2:30 p.m. Friday in the Central Baptist Church with the Rev. W. R. McCoy and Dr. H. P. Hackney in charge. Burial will be in the Greenbrier Burial Park.

The body will remain at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors.
