Barney O. Lilly, Veteran Road Commission Engineer, Succumbs Saturday

Funeral services were held this afternoon at 2:00 o'clock at the Ronald Meadows Funeral Parlors on Temple street for Barney Oris Lilly, 50-yearold widely-known Hinton resident, who died Saturday afternoon about 4:00 o'clock in a Charleston hospital.

The Rev. H. P. Hackney, pastor of the Central Baptist church, officiated and members of the Hinton Masonic lodge served as pallbearers.

Burial was to follow at the Crews cemetery near Jumping Branch with grave services under the auspices of the Masonic lodge, of which he was a member.

Mr. Lilly was employed by the state road commission as an engineer for a number of years.

He suffered serious injuries in an automobile accident near Rainelle about a year ago, and never fully recovered.

He is survived by a twin brother, Otho Lilly, of Kanawha City, another brother, Alf Lilly, of Jumping Branch, and two sisters, Mrs. M. L. McClung, of Hinton, and Mrs. Lee Harper, of Charleston.
